



Tire Maintenance

Tires are largely responsible for keeping your car on the ground and moving in the direction that you want it to go – two extremely important aspects of safe driving.

Monthly



Check tire air pressure

Mileage: about every 1,000 miles

Why?

Underinflated tires wear down faster, reduce acceleration and handling, and negatively impact fuel efficiency

Depending on tread wear



Rotation

Mileage: about every 5,000 to 8,000 miles

Why?

Car tires will wear out differently, and rotation significantly extends the life of the tire

Tread wear or damage



Replacement

Mileage: about every 25,000 to 50,000 miles; Immediately if damaged

Why?

Tread continually wears down and eventually off with use, reducing traction

Car owners are advised to always refer to their owner's manual for maintenance intervals for their specific vehicle.
